Crossroads: An Indo-Spanish dance ensemble

While Kathak is one of the nine classical dances of India originating in the third century and performed in temples as a way of narrating mythological stories, Flamenco's origins are thought to be in the Roman migration from Northwest India to Spain between the ninth and 14th centuries and later performed by Gitanos (Gypsies) in Spain as a way of expressing their life's struggles. The two art forms have striking similarities and will be brought together by the Royal Opera House and Avid Learning, featuring Kathak exponent Aditi Bhagwat and Flamenco artist Bettina Castaño.
